

2023 President's UFO Challenge Rules (as of 1/1/2023)

- **Identify up to 12 unfinished* projects** you would like to work on in 2023**.
 - To encourage charity donations, up to three (3) projects on your list can be designated as charity projects you will donate to the Charity committee. While you are encouraged to finish an entire charity quilt before donating, a quilt top will be considered a completed UFO without quilting or binding. Just make sure you seek credit from the president or vice-president before you turn in the top.
 - **New entrants may enter challenge at any time after the challenge begins in January 2023
- **Print the project entry form and pay \$5 entry fee at a guild meeting** to *officially* join the challenge and receive completed project raffle tickets.
 - If you'd rather not enter the official challenge, you are welcome to print out a form to help keep you motivated to work on your UFOs throughout the coming year.
- **Beginning in the January 1, 2023 newsletter**, a project # will be published in the newsletter and also posted in the guild Facebook group. The project # is your prompt indicating which project on your list you should work on during the month.
 - While this challenge is designed to motivate you to complete a project, you do not have to finish each project in the month the Project # is drawn. To receive credit for a completion of any project, a project must be credited no later than the December, 2023 holiday gathering.
- **Definition of a completed project:**
 - **Quilt:** Fully assembled/pieced, quilted/tied and bound (Exception: Up to three (3) charity quilt tops as defined in the first bullet of this document)
 - **Handcrafted/sewn item (not a quilt):** Completed and ready for use
 - **Knitting/Crochet:** Completed and ready for use
 - **Stitchery/Embroidery:** Top completed
- **Bring completed project(s) along with your original project list, to a guild meeting and show completed items to the Guild President or Vice-President.** You will receive one raffle ticket to add to the raffle ticket box for each item completed on your list.
 - **Winter non-AZ Residents:** If your project is completed at your alternate residence in a different state, we understand. You do not have to bring the actual project to get credit for a UFO finish. To request credit, simply email a photo of the completed project to the guild president or vice-president for approval. They will make sure your ticket gets deposited in the raffle bucket.
- **Challenge Winner:** At the December, 2023, holiday potluck/event, a winning ticket will be drawn from all of the accumulated completed project tickets. **Winner will receive 50% of the total entry fees collected from challenge participants.**
