Guidelines for Quilt Entries

Completeness and Due Dates	Please read all the information before filling out the Entry Form. Incomplete forms will be returned! Please make a copy of your entry and keep a copy of this information. Mail entry forms by January 21 th , 2025. Mail to: April Layher, 238 W. SG Posey St., Vail, AZ 85641
Acceptance	Notification of entry acceptance will be sent via email by February 15, 2025. If you prefer notification via postal mail. include a self-addressed, stamped, letter-sized envelope with each quilt entry form. This should be affixed to the upper left-hand corner of the entry form underneath the quilt photo.
Eligibility Current Members	Only Valley Quilter Guild members with current membership standing are permitted to enter, and may enter up to 3 quilts in the show with no entry fee. A quilt that has not been previously shown at a Splendor in the Desert quilt show may be entered.
Public / New Members	Quilt entry fee for the public/non-members is \$30, and includes a GVQG one year membership. Checks for non-member entries: please make out to Valley Quilter's Guild.
Types of Quilts Accepted	Entries must be made by the Entrant and MUST BE QUILTED . Unusually shaped entries may require additional information. Quilts measuring 96" or longer may require a hanging sleeve. See your acceptance letter for details Please contact the Entry Chair for answers to questions.
Entry Form Guidelines	Please use a SEPARATE FORM for EACH QUILT ENTRY Each Entry Form MUST have: A photograph (size 4"x 6") of the actual entry which accurately depicts colors and style. Please copy on photo paper or cardstock – and NO full sized photos. Each Photo must be stapled to the upper left hand corner of the Entry Forms. The quilt does not need to be finished for the photograph. Photo will not be returned. The Description of Entry should be 75 words or less and include: why it was made, who it is for, the pattern name with credit given to the designer (or yourself if an original), Include names of any others involved in the process; the quilter, group project members, class project etc.
Sales Option	If you would like to feature your quilt entry for sale at the show, please check the box in the Sales Option section. You will be responsible to tag and price your quilt. By participating in the Sales Option, you agree to donating 20% of the selling price to the Valley Quilter's Guild.
Quilt Delivery and Handling	Instructions for entry delivery to the Quilt Show will be included in your Acceptance Letter. <i>We will make every effort to treat your entry with care and respect, but cannot guarantee to provide special handling for delicate items. Valley Quilter's Guild does not provide insurance for entries.</i>
