

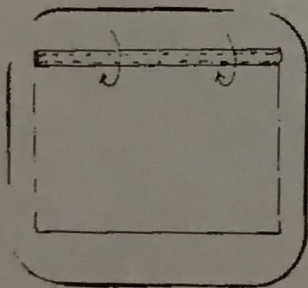
PILLOW TOTES

Stuff you'll need for each pillow case/tote:

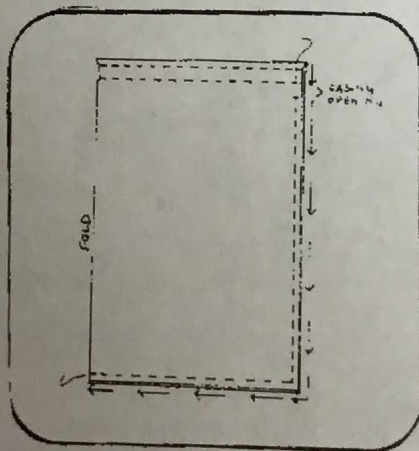
- 1 yard cotton fabric, 45" wide in non directional print
- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards drawstring/cording

I cut the yard in half -- making 2

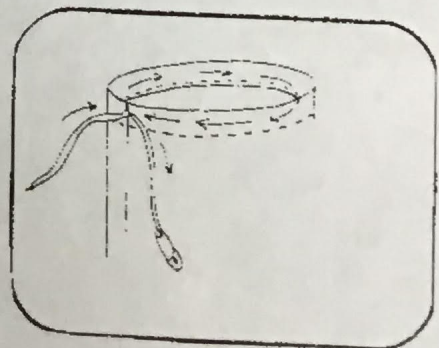
1. Open your piece of fabric. Do not cut off selvages. Along one of the long edges, fold under $\frac{1}{2}$ inch to the wrong side and press. Fold under another $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inches and press again forming your drawstring casing.
2. On the casing stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ inch from top edge along length. Make another stitch line $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ inch from bottom edge of casing along length. This forms approximately a 1 inch opening for the cording to go through.
3. Fold piece in half selvaige to selvaige. Starting at top stitch down to first stitching line (back stitch or secure). Skip over approximately 1 inch with no sewing for opening. Then, start sewing at second stitch line from bottom of casing and continue down the whole length of the pillow slip. When you get to the corner, turn and stitch to the end along the bottom of the pillow tote.
4. Thread cording through and tie ends together. Press and go on to the next one.
